



### **The 183 day rule**

It is possible to order ID06 cards for shorter periods of 1,2,3,4,5 months or a specific number of days as long as the months or days together do not exceed 6 months (183 days) over a 12 month period. If this is not possible, due to valid reasons, then an dispensation can be sought to order a new ID06 card, see the below assessment basis for dispensation.

### **Basic rule**

An EU citizen posted by a foreign company may only stay in Sweden for 183 days (6 months) during a 12 month period.

Companies with posted workers who have then received ID06 cards with a total maximum period of 6 months according to the 183 day rule can apply for an dispensation for ordering an additional ID06 card, if it is then proven that the person has not resided in Sweden for 183 days over a 12-month period.

### **Application**

When applying for an dispensation for a supplementary ID06 card, ID06 Company control may check the person's log-ins and log-outs activated in ID06 personnel ledger.

Then it is also checked that the Working Time Act is followed, ie that the person has not worked more hours than the legislation allows.

If it appears in that review that the information provided by the companies in their application for dispensation is not in accordance with the control data available, then the company and its ID06 card may be able to be excluded in the ID06 system. Here, the company can be excluded in the ID06 system both in case of violation of tax legislation and in violation of the Working Time Act.

**Assessment basis:** An application for an dispensation for a new ID06 card must be indicated with information according to the following points.

**In order for a dispensation to be approved:** Then it is also necessary that there is an A1 certificate or an application for an A1 certificate which is valid for the time the dispensation relates to.

- Company name and organization number
- ID06 card number for persons ID06 card to which application for dispensation refers.
- Indicate which dates the person has resided and has not resided in Sweden during the period that the current ID06 card is valid.
- Enter during which time period for a new ID06 card to which the application for dispensation relates.
